Angel was referred to Easterseals VT's Compass program by her mother due to health concerns for her quality of life facing Spina Bifida health challenges. With guidance from Lana Deppert, Compass Youth Coordinator, Angel has gained confidence and independence. Compass serves at-risk youth ages 12 to 23 to enhance well-being and stability.

Lana helped get the family's van repaired, which improved Angel's mobility, and connected her to a Special Olympics bowling program that brought her joy and friendship. When the program concluded, Angel was disappointed. Thanks to the generosity of donors, Easterseals VT was able to provide Angel with a year-long bowling pass to continue to support her wellbeing.

As Angel's 24th birthday approaches, Lana is helping her establish a stable routine and pursue a counselor position at Youth Rally, a camp for youth with bowel and bladder conditions.
